<i>These notes are duplicated in the application to fund a table tennis table</i> The most recent set of accounts (for year ending October 2019) show an income of £15,891 and expenses of £16,360 (plus an outstanding rent invoice for £1700 making total expenses for the year £18,060). This is a net loss of £2,169. The Club had reserves of £5305 at the year end that can cover the loss leaving a reserve of £3136 for the current year, equivalent to two months of expenses. This is a second application from the club for a grant. Under the terms and conditions of your Community Grants, they are not disbarred from making additional applications where the funding is for a different project. <i>Councillors may therefore consider this application as valid.</i>
