Background

Item 8.1 of the Engagement Policy Action Plan agreed in September 2019 was to increase the number of council noticeboards around the parish. This discussion paper aims to agree the criteria for choosing which type of noticeboard we will use and where they will be located.

Use

Information and promotion of the parish council's work and projects

- Do we make space for community notices?
- If yes, how much space?
- What criteria for use?
- Who decides?
- Who has access?

Size

For parish council use only, equivalent to 8x A4 pages

- 4 pages – council agenda/minutes
- 1 page – Contact details for councillors with photos
- 1 page – Report it – information on PC services and how to report
- 2 pages – statutory notices (for example, elections, audit etc)

Statutory pages will not be used all the time and the space can be used to promote other PC services (eg grants, allotments, climate change meetings)

Issues

- Location. Pengover Green; Island Shop; Lower Clicker.
- Do we replace the ones at Merrymeet and Menheniot?
- Permissions
- Fixing (to a wall or on supports in the ground)

Materials

- Wood
- Metal
- Colour

Maintenance (fixing and removing of information)
