Dear John,

I understand that Menheniot Parish Council may consider requests for grants of up to £100.00 to support suitable projects. The Poads Trust resident's have a project that I hope fits MPC's criteria.

Last year the residents managed to produce a magnificent crop of tomatoes and cucumbers, using some rather inconvenient plastic bags filled with growing medium. The bags, in order to be in the best position for sunlight, limited the movement of the residents in the garden. This year the residents have found a moveable planter that waters itself. The units are on wheels and hence easily moveable. They are ideal for small spaces. The wheeled planters are £40. In addition, a set of cane supports which are available, up which to grow the tomatoes and/or cucumbers, are a further £15. The residents would like to buy two sets (total cost £110.00). The Trust will help with the purchase of the appropriate numbers of bags of organic growing medium + some roses to replace existing aging or dying roses.
